Election Procedures for USEF Board of Director Seats for Hunter Discipline - 2009

1. The members of the USHJA Board of Directors (BOD) shall send in writing to the USHJA office c/o Susan Dotson, a list of nominations for the two (2) opening Hunter designated seats on the USEF Board of Directors. Nominees must be Senior Active members of the USEF and USHJA who have designated hunter as their primary discipline. There is no limit to how many individuals a USHJA Director may nominate. Each list of nominees must be signed by the USHJA Director and their membership number must be included for their nominations to count. Nominations must be received by 5:00 pm EDT on October 15, 2009 in order to qualify for inclusion on the ballot. Fax, express or regular mail is acceptable for nominations.
2. A ballot will be created including the names of qualified nominees received from the USHJA Directors. Names will be listed in alphabetical order and ballots will be sent to the members of the USHJA BOD with instructions to vote for two (2) individuals. Ballots will be mailed on October 16, 2009 and completed ballots must be returned to the USHJA office c/o Susan Dotson on or before 5:00pm EDT on November 4, 2009 in the appropriate self addressed envelope, which has been included for each USHJA Director's use, in order for their vote to count.
3. The nominees with the two highest numbers of votes will serve a term of four (4) years representing the hunter discipline of USHJA on the USEF Board of Directors. In the event of a tie, a run-off election will be conducted between the affected nominees. The next two nominees with the highest number of votes will serve as alternates.
