2010 Adult Amateur Hunter Horse Zone Specification Comparisons

Restrictions Summary

Zone 1: Horse/rider combination is not eligible for any other USEF rated classes in which fence height exceeds 3', except Equitation classes.

Zone 2: Rider may not cross enter into any other class where the fences exceed 3'6" except Adult Amateur Jumper. Riders may cross enter between the Adult Hunter and the Amateur Owner division if the rider owns the horse he or she is showing in the Adult Amateur division. Riders can cross enter between the Amateur Owner 3'3" and 3'6", but horses may not cross enter between the Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same show.

Zone 3: A rider in the Children's Hunter Division is not eligible to compete in classes where fences exceed 3'3", except Children's/Adult Jumpers. Riders who compete in the 3'3" Amateur Owner Hunter classes must show a horse they own in Adult Amateur Hunter classes if they compete in both at the same show.

Zone 4: Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters.

Zone 5: Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except the Adult Amateur Jumper and Adult Amateur Owner Hunter. Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter division may compete 1 different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division and must own or have an USEF registered lease of said horse.

Zone 6: Riders can cross enter between the Amateur Owner 3'3" and 3'6", but horses may not cross enter between the Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same show.

Zone 7: The same rider/horse (pony) combination may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation excepted) in which fence heights exceed 3'3". The horse or pony may be shown by a different rider in any other division or section at the same show except Amateur Owner Hunter or a different age group in Adult Amateur Hunter.

Zone 8: Horse/rider combination is restricted from showing in both Amateur Owner and Adult Amateur Hunter Divisions at the same show.

Zone 9: Horses and Adult Amateur riders entered in Adult Amateur Hunter sections may not compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter section at the same show. Riders may not show in any classes in which the fences are 3'9" and over at the same show.

Zone 10: Horses or riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner hunter class (at the same show). Riders may not cross enter into First Year, Second Year or Regular Working Hunters at the same show. Adult Amateur Riders may not cross enter into any class exceeding 3'3" except Adult Amateur Jumpers, Junior/Amateur Modified Jumpers, Equitation and Medal Classes. No cross entry restrictions at one-day shows.

Zone 11: No cross entry restrictions.

Zone 12: No cross entry restrictions.
