**2022 ZONE 1 HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION SPECIFICATIONS
(CT, MA, ME, NH, RI, VT)**

In accordance with GR1111.4: Canada and NY are contiguous states. For contiguous state points New York includes New Jersey. Contiguous points earned in USEF/Equine Canada licensed competitions will only receive national points in USEF rated divisions.

JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS:

- To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count.
- Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification. Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Sections offered and requirements:

- Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections

Cross Entry:

Riders:

Riders may cross enter between the Adult Amateur Hunter and the Amateur Owner section if the rider owns the horse he or she is showing in the Adult Amateur section.

Horses:

Horses may not cross enter between the Adult Amateur and Amateur Owner Hunter sections at the same show.

Horse and Rider Combination:

Horse-and-rider combination is not eligible for any other USEF rated classes in which fence height exceeds 3'0" (exception: Equitation 3'3", USHJA National Hunter Derby).

Fence height:

- 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height.
- Courses will not be adjusted for ponies.
- Combinations will be permitted.

Combining/Dividing Sections:

May be split into three sections:

- Adult Amateurs 18– 35
- Adult Amateurs 36– 49
- Adult Amateurs 50 & over

Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than six (6) entries in a section. If there are six (6) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. Adult Amateur Hunter and Children's Hunter may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Adult Amateur Hunter 18- 35
- Adult Amateur 36- 49
- Adult Amateur 50 & over

LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Eligibility:

Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

Cross Entry:

Riders:

Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 2'9".

Fence Height:

- 2'6"

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Low Adult Amateur Hunter and Low Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section:

- Low Adult Amateur Hunter

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, all USHJA programs, properties, events and related specifications are subject to change in accordance with federal, state and local laws and regulations.

ADULT AMATEUR JUMPER

Sections offered and requirements:

- Low Adult Amateur Jumper
- High Adult Amateur Jumper

Cross Entry:

Rider:

Riders may not compete in any other class at the same competition where fences exceed 1.15m except the USEF Talent Search Class.

Horse/Pony

Horses may show at 1.40m or below with another rider.

Horse and Rider Combination:

Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

Fence Height:

- Low Adult Amateur Jumper .90m – 1.00m
- High Adult Amateur Jumper 1.10m- 1.15m

Combining/Dividing Sections:

Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may also be combined with Children's Jumper if so stated in the prize list.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Low Adult Amateur Jumper
- High Adult Amateur Jumper

AGE GROUP EQUITATION: ADULT SECTION

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE

Sections offered and requirements:

- Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under
- Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17

Cross Entry:

Rider:

Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3" (exception: Equitation, Children's Jumpers, Pony Jumpers and the USHJA National Hunter Derby).

Horses/Ponies:

n/a

Horse and rider combination:

n/a

Fence Height:

- 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height
- Combinations will be permitted unless combined with Children's Hunter Pony.

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Children's Hunter Horse section may be divided by age of rider: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under and Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17.

If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either age section, the two sections must be combined. The Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony, when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

Alternatively, the Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. The Children's Hunter (horse & pony) section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

When sections are combined and there are more than 16 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under
- Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE

Eligibility:

Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

Cross Entry:

Riders:

Riders may not cross enter at the same competition into the Children's Hunter, Pony Hunter or any class/section where fences exceed 2'9".

Fence Height:

- 2'6"

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Low Children's Hunter and Low Adult Amateur Hunter sections may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section:

- Low Children's Hunter Horse

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY

Sections offered and requirements:

- Small/Medium Children's Pony
- Large Children's Pony

Cross Entry:

Rider:

Riders may only show one pony in either the 2'0" or the 2'6" height of the Children's Pony Hunter sections(s) when also competing on multiple ponies in the Regular or Green Pony Hunter sections(s). Riders may only show one pony in the Regular or Green Pony Hunter sections when competing on multiple ponies in the Children's Pony Hunter section(s) (exception: Model and Under Saddle classes).

Horse/Pony

Ponies cannot cross enter into Regular and/or Green Pony Hunter section at the same competition.

Horse and Rider Combination

n/a

Fence Height:

- Small/Medium Ponies: 2'0" with spreads not to exceed height of fence
- Large Ponies: 2'6" with spreads not to exceed height of fence
- Distances will not be adjusted
- Combinations will not be permitted

Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Children's Hunter Pony section may be divided by size. If the Children's Hunter Pony is offered divided by size it will be divided: Children's Hunter Pony Small/Medium and Children's Hunter Pony Large.

If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either height section, the two sections must be combined. The Children's Hunter Pony section may be combined with Children's Hunter Horse when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

The Children's Hunter (horse & pony) section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section.

When sections are combined and there are more than 16 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Children's Hunter Pony - Small/Medium
- Children's Hunter Pony - Large

CHILDREN'S JUMPER

Sections offered and Requirements:

- Low Children's Jumper
- High Children's Jumper

Cross Entry:

Rider:

Riders may not compete in any other class at the same competition where fences exceed 1.15m except the USEF Talent Search Class.

Horse/Pony

Horses may show at 1.40m or below with another rider.

Horse and Rider Combination:

Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

Fence Height:

- Low Children's Jumper .90m-1.00m
- High Children's Jumper 1.10m- 1.15m

Combining/Dividing Sections:

Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may also be combined with Adult Amateur if so stated in the prize list.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section:

- Low Children's Jumper section
- High Children's Jumper

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, all USHJA programs, properties, events and related specifications are subject to change in accordance with federal, state and local laws and regulations.

AGE GROUP EQUITATION: CHILDREN'S/JUNIOR SECTION

Sections Offered:

- Equitation 11 & Under
- Equitation 12- 14
- Equitation 15- 17

Cross Entry:

No cross entry restrictions for the horse and rider.

Fence Height:

- Equitation 11 & Under:
 - Minimum 2'0", maximum 2'6" - management must state height at which class will be offered.
 - Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout.
 - Course design must comply with EQ108.8 and 108.11, combinations not permitted.
- Equitation 12- 14:
 - Minimum 2'9", maximum 3'3" - management must state height at which class will be offered.
 - Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout.
 - Course design must comply with EQ108.8 and 108.11, combinations ~~not~~ permitted.
- Equitation 15- 17:
 - Minimum 3'0", maximum 3'6" - management must state height at which class will be offered.
 - Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout.
 - Course design must comply with EQ108.8 and 108.11, combinations ~~not~~ permitted.

Combining/Dividing Sections:

Age-Group Equitation Sections may be combined as necessary, jumping at their respective heights, to meet the three (3) entry minimum requirement for points to be awarded.

Stallions are prohibited when adult equitation sections are combined with children's/junior equitation sections. EQ101.3.

Awards:

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections:

- Equitation 11 & Under
- Equitation 12- 14
- Equitation 15- 17
